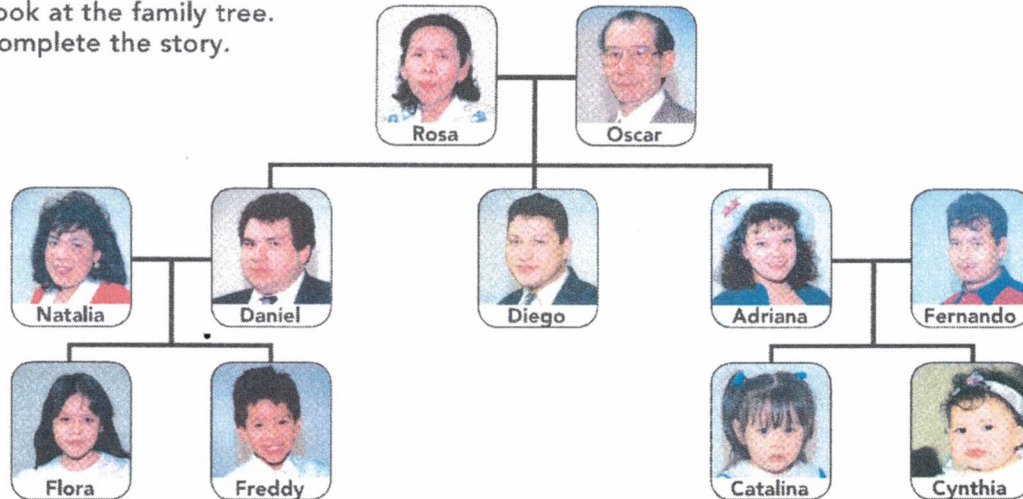


## 1 READING A DIAGRAM A FAMILY TREE

Diego is the uncle<sup>13</sup> of Flora, Freddy, Catalina, and Cynthia.
