

Consonants are letters that are NOT vowels.

The consonants are

B C D F G H J K L M N P Q R S T V W X
and sometimes Y

Sometimes, two consonants go together to make one new sound.

These are called "consonant digraphs."

Some consonant digraphs are:

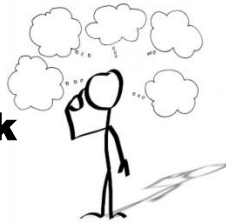
CH CHARGER, charger
