SUBJECT PRONOUNS

1. Find the SUBJECT of the sentence.

The SUBJECT is the person or thing doing the action. In the sentence, "She and I went to the store," the SUBJECTS are "SHE and I," since WE "went to the store."

The **SUBJECT** pronouns are:
I, HE, SHE, THEY and WE

2. Choose a SUBJECT pronoun for the SUBJECT of a sentence.



OBJECT PRONOUNS

1. Find the OBJECT of the sentence.

The OBJECT is the person or thing receiving the action. In the sentence, "These books are for Mike and me," the SUBJECT is BOOKS. The OBJECTS are MIKE and ME, since we are getting the BOOKS.

The **OBJECT** pronouns are:
ME, HIM, HER, THEM, and US
